Fans:

1. Applauding during introduction of players, coaches and officials
2. Applauding at end of contest
3. Accepting all decisions of officials
4. Leading fans in positive school yells
5. Showing concern and respect for injured player (regardless of team)
6. Encouraging surrounding people to display only sportsmanlike conduct

Players:

7. Coaches/players seeking out opposing coaches and participants to recognize them for performance during and after contests
8. Shaking hands with opponents who foul out while (both sets of fans recognize players performance with applause)
9. Applauding at end of contest
10. Showing concern and respect for injured player (regardless of team)
