The Board took the following action:

Page 2 APPROVED to schedule the Executive Board meeting for Sunday, March 22, and the Winter Coalition on Monday, March 23, 2020.

Page 2 APPROVED on THIRD AND FINAL READING a six-year rotation of the 2A, 3A and 4A State Volleyball Championships between Saint Martin's University and the Yakima Valley SunDome beginning with the 2020-21 school year (rotation attached).

Page 3 APPROVED the proposed points for Cheer and Dance/Drill to be included in the Scholastic Cup.

Page 3 APPROVED to exempt football from new WIAA handbook rule 17.12.4 (attached).

Page 3 APPROVED nine editorial changes for the 2019-20 WIAA handbook.

Page 4 APPROVED the year-to-date financial report.

Page 4 APPROVED the final winter tournament report.

Page 4 APPROVED on THIRD AND FINAL READING the 2019-20 Association budget.

Page 4 DENIED the request of the Cheer Coaches Association to change the date of the State Cheerleading Championships due to a conflict of the date with a national cheerleading event.

Page 5 APPROVED a one-year probation for the Renton High School basketball coach for violating WIAA handbook rule 20.7.0 following a state tournament basketball game on March 1, 2019.

Page 5 APPROVED on THIRD AND FINAL READING the 2019-23 WIAA/WOA Statewide Agreement.

Page 5 APPROVED John Wallwork for this subsequent three-year term as the combined district WIAA Executive Board member.

Page 5 APPROVED Greg Whitmore as the 2019-20 WIAA Executive Board President.

Page 5 APPROVED Tim Thomsen as the 2019-20 WIAA Executive Board Vice President.

Page 6 APPROVED the proposed changes to the 2019-20 Bound for State Tournament Regulations.

Page 6 APPROVED Kiwanis Park in Yakima as the site for the 2019 State Slowpitch Championships to be held on November 1-2, 2019.

Page 6 APPROVED Mariachi as a permanent category at the State Ensemble Contest beginning with the 2019-20 school year.

Page 7 APPROVED that schools may appeal their classification in football to coincide with the allocation cycle.
