Friday, February 9

3:15 Athlete entrance doors will open, Teams can start to arrive
Locker rooms and check scales are available.

8:00 Athlete entrance doors will open, Teams can start to arrive. Locker rooms and check scales are available.

9:00 Weigh-in will be started by *weight class*.

All participants must be in the weigh-in area by 8:55 am. Line-up by weight class.

Buses: Drop off will be available back by the gym. All buses that stay on sight are required to park in the front parking lot off of 320th after dropping of coaches/athletes back by the gym.
Please do not arrive before 3:15 on Friday February 9th.

Weigh-In: **Picture ID is required for all wrestlers.**

Weigh-in will be completed by weight class. The head referee or designee plus a supervisor will serve as weigh-in officials. A coach must be present when wrestlers weigh in.

Mats: Four mats will be used for both dates. Two mats for finals.

Wrestling Area: Only wrestlers, coaches, officials and designated school staff are permitted in the wrestling area. Spectators seating is limited to the designated bleacher area.

Checkouts: Wristband must be on for re-admittance to the gym (and for the 2nd day if a two day ticket is purchased)

Passes: Four coaches, two managers, eight cheerleaders (in uniform with advisor), and one student video, photo, and newspaper representatives (school authorized credentials) are admitted at no charge but their names must be on the pass gate list. Only WCD authorized passes, WSCA (coach's association) passes and WSSAAA (athletic director association) passes will be honored! **School District, League, WIAA, WOA, etc. will NOT be accepted.**

Pass Gate Lists: Coaches need to submit pass gate lists via **email to aduvall@fwps.org before 3:00pm on Thursday February 8th**. Schools who do not email in a pass gate list before February 8th will complete one before entering the gym foyer which means time spent outside for everyone in your program while Head Coach is completing this form.

(The 2017 Pass Gate List experience was not as positive as it could be. ensure your team can walk right in upon arrival because the pass gate list has been emailed and replied to as received. Please also encourage parents/fans not attempt to come through the pass gate with the team. Thank you.)

Signage: Bands NOT allowed at the tournament. No signs will be permitted except for official school banners.

Balloons: NO Balloons allowed.

Officials: Assigned by the WIAA.

Games Committee: Any disputes occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Manager and he/she will confer with the Games Committee. Their decision will be final. The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32 – Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed.

The Tournament Games Committee will consist of:

- Head Official
- Tournament Manager or Assistant
- Coach from neutral school

Awards: Medal pins for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd and ribbons for 4th, 5th individual places.

All wrestlers will wear their school warm-ups on the podium. NO HATS, HOODS, OR HEAD PHONES ON THE PODIUM OR FOR WIAA STATE PROGRAM PHOTOS

Qualifiers: The top FIVE (5) wrestlers advancing to the WIAA Mat Classic XXVII at the Tacoma Dome on February 16-17 2018. The sixth place finisher will be the Region 2 alternate to state.

Bracketing: With two sub-regions qualifying six wrestlers each to this regional, the bracket will be the same for each weight class. The bracket will be flipped top-to-bottom every weight, though they are the same bracket.

The letter is the qualifying tournament designation; the number is the tournament placing.
