**8:00 AM**- Skin checks and Weigh-ins

**9:00 AM** – Coaches meeting in the AHS Community Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor immediately following weigh-ins.

**10:00 AM** – Wrestling Begins

All sessions will be run back to back on three (3) mats until championship matches are completed. For Finals: 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> on center mat; 3<sup>rd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> on two side mats.

## Weigh-In

- a. National Federation Wrestling Rules weigh-in procedures will be used at all WIAA regional Tournaments.
- b. Athletes must bring photo I.D. and weigh-in cards which will be provided to coaches upon arrival.**
- c. Officials will be at the weigh-ins for skin checks. Officials will be at each scale.
- d. There will be certified doctor at weigh-in available to check any wrestler.

### **Floor Restrictions**

This is a WIAA post-season event. Spectators will not be allowed in the wrestling areas.

- a. There will be a designated area for spectators and team/coaches.
- b. Only two representatives per school allowed on each mat.
- c. No one will be allowed to stand along the mats.
- d. Limit of four (4) cheerleaders will be allowed mat side.
- e. Photographers and video Cameras- Will NOT be allowed on the mats/floor Please inform parents that they will not be allowed to photograph in the wrestling area.

### **Tournament Points.**

All tournament scoring will be as stated in the national Federation Rule Book. The top six (6) placers in each weight class earn points at the following ratio:

<b>First Place .....</b>	<b>16 Points</b>	<b>Fourth Place .....</b>	<b>7 Points</b>
<b>Second Place .....</b>	<b>12 Points</b>	<b>Fifth Place .....</b>	<b>5 Points</b>
<b>Third Place .....</b>	<b>9 Points</b>	<b>Sixth Place .....</b>	<b>3 Points</b>

### **Awards**

Individual 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place at each weight will receive a metal from the WIAA that will be presented during the championship session.

### **Qualifying for State**

**Top THREE in each weight class will qualify for the WIAA Mat Classic.**

The 4<sup>th</sup> place finisher will become the alternate at the Mat Classic.

### **Protests**

Any dispute occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Director who will confer with the Tournament Committee. The committee decision will be final. The WIAA expulsion rule (23.32 – Conduct eligibility rules and penalties) will be followed.

### **WIAA Tournament Rules**

WIAA tournament rules will apply. (I.e. Sportsmanship, signs, noisemakers, floor restrictions, coaches in the corner and admissions.)
