Weigh-In: Will be in the Upper wrestling room. (Please see WIAA rules on last page)

Mats: Four mats will be used through the consolation rounds. Two mats will be

used for the final Championship Round (1st & 2nd Places).

Games Committee: Will consist of 3 members – tournament manager

(or designee), head official and a neutral coach

Officials: TBD by WIAA





Floor access: Limited to three school representatives, two coaches and a

statistician/filmer. Cheerleaders will only be allowed to cheer during the finals (on 2 mats). If a team exceeds this limit, a warning will be given, then an unsportsmanlike team penalty may be assessed, resulting in a

loss of team points.

Medical: A Certified Trainer will be available during the tournament along with

onsite EMT's from The Pasco Fire Department.

Blood Clean up: Paper towels, spray bottles, and red disposal cans will be available in the

central mat area. Coaches and trainers will clean wrestlers.

Ejections: Ejection for first instance of flagrant misconduct (Federation Rule). Or,

ejection for second instance of unsportsmanlike conduct (Federation Rule) of an "abusive" nature (WIAA Standard). An ejected participant is

finished for the tournament and the remainder of the season.

Filming: Coaches, please alert parents that they will not be allowed on the

main floor.

Media: Please have your media representatives (radio, TV, and newspaper)

check in with the tournament manager for information and registration.

Signs: Only one official school banner or sign will be allowed in the arena.

Passes: The Region IV Tournament pass policy will follow WIAA guidelines:





- One (1) pass per participant
- One (1) pass administrator/supervisor (no

floor access)

- One (1) cheer supervisory pass (no floor access) issued at door when cheer team arrives
- Coaches passes:
 - 2 passes (provided in team info packet)
 - 3 passes (upon request by tournament manager if team has 3-9 participants)
 - 4 passes (upon request by tournament manager if team has 10 or more participants)

No school or district passes will be accepted.

Press passes and WIAA passes will be accepted

Cheerleaders: A cheerleader roster signed by the school principal must be presented to

the tournament host. A cheer coach must be present. Cheerleaders must wear uniforms to be admitted or re-admitted. *Cheerleaders will only be permitted to cheer mat side during the championship finals on*

Saturday evening.

Valuables: Each team is responsible for their own valuables.

Towels: Each team must provide its own towels.

T-Shirts, etc. Will be available from the WIAA vendor.

Regional Tournament.

WIAA 2017-2018 Weigh-In Procedures

All student-athletes will weigh-in wearing a school issued wrestling uniform that meets WIAA and NFHS requirements (excluding headgear and footwear). There will be no weight allowance given for uniforms. The weight management weigh-in used for the descent plan will also require the wrestlers to weigh-in with a school issued wrestling uniform that meets WIAA and NFHS requirements.

Weigh-in/skin check procedures:

Wrestlers should only have a wrestling school issued uniform on when entering the weigh-in area. All wrestlers must submit to a skin disease screening prior to weigh-in. Male wrestlers will remove their straps or tops, while females will remain in full uniform for the skin check. Wrestlers will not be allowed to carry additional clothing or anything other than the weigh-in card or skin clearance documents with them during weigh-ins. Athletes shall weigh-in with a school issued uniform on as it is designed to wear during competition. The official has full authority of the skin check and weigh-in process regulations required for an athlete to compete.
