Congratulations on earning a berth to the 1B/2B WIAA Regional Wrestling Tournament. Please read through the following information and let me know if you have any questions.

Date: February 10th, 2018

Where: Kalama Middle/High School

Parking: Buses/school vehicles may drop off athletes in front of gymnasium and then park across the street at the open gravel lot (please see map).

Weigh-in: Weigh-ins will be conducted in the lower gym at 8am and will adhere to all WIAA and NFHS guidelines. Photo ID will be required. As a suggestion, have coaches have picture ID on their phones in case needed. No ID=no wrestling.

Gates: Open to the public at 8:30am. Wrestling will begin at 9:30am.

Officials: Officials are selected and assigned by the WOA/WIAA.

Medical: A Certified Athletic Trainer will be on site.

Format: Matches will take place on three mats. Finals will be on one mat under the spotlight. The top 5 finishers in each weight category will move on to the state competition. 6th place qualifier will attend as an alternate.

Brackets: Track Wrestling will be used to manage the tournament. Fans may login and follow along at trackwrestling.com or with track wrestling mobile (trackwrestling.com/mobile).

Hospitality: There will be a coaches/officials hospitality room located in the wrestling room on the north end of the lower gymnasium. It will be open all day with breakfast, lunch, and snacks available. Wristbands will be required for entry and will be included in your packet.

Coaches Meeting: Coaches will meet in the wrestling room at the conclusion of weigh-ins.

Concessions: A full concession stand will be available all day.

Merchandise: Rush Team Apparel will be on site with merchandise for purchase.

Protests: All protests will be resolved on site by the games committee. Committees will consist of: Head official, tournament director, and 2 uninvolved coaches.

3:15-4:30: Round 4, 2 mats
4:30-4:50: Setup for finals
4:50-7:15: Round 5/Finals, 1 mat (Awards between matches)

**Note that we will wrestle straight through with the only scheduled break being after round 2 for lunch, and a short break to set up for finals.

Personal belongings: The bleachers will need to be clear of all team/wrestling equipment and be open for fans. Teams will be assigned locker rooms for storage of personal belongings.
