The Region IV Boys and Girls Wrestling Championships are scheduled for Saturday, February 10, 2018 at East Valley High School in Spokane Valley, WA. The students and staff at EVHS welcome you and look forward to working with you to create an exciting wrestling event. Our experienced tournament staff is thrilled to host this event.

Tournament

****All Times are Approximate and will be dictated by Track Wrestling**

Weigh-In: Will be in 2 locations, (boys wrestling room 3 scales and auxiliary gym 3 scales), both located on the lower level. Three scales will be used. Wrestlers must bring identification and must have any doctor's note for any skin condition.

Mats: Four mats will be used through the consolation rounds. Two mats will be used for the final Championship Round (1st & 2nd Places). The Finals will be book ended on 2 mats for boys and 2 mats for the girls.

Games Committee: Head Official, Alec Vermaire and John Cerna.

Officials: TBD

Floor access: Limited to two school representatives and four cheerleaders for each match NO EXCEPTIONS. If a team exceeds this limit, a warning will be given, then an unsportsmanlike team penalty may be assessed, resulting in a loss of team points. During respective matches, team video will be permitted from designated mat side locations. - Warm up area:** The auxiliary gym will be available for coaches and wrestlers (in uniform) only.
- Medical:** A certified trainer and medical doctor will be available during the tournament. Dr. Tim Manson will be the final authority on any medical questions or disputes.
- Blood Clean up:** Paper towels, spray bottles, and disposal cans will be available in the central mat area. Coaches and trainers will clean wrestlers.
- Ejections:** Ejection for first instance of flagrant misconduct (Federation Rule). Or, ejection for second instance of unsportsmanlike conduct (Federation Rule) of an “abusive” nature (WIAA Standard). An ejected participant is finished for the tournament and the remainder of the season.
- Filming:** Team filming from designated mat side locations only. **NO FLOOR ACCESS!** Coaches, please alert parents that they will not be allowed on the main floor for film or photography. The entire tournament will be available on TrackCast for a minimal fee from Track Wrestling. [2A Region 4 Boys](#), [Region 4 Girls](#)
- Media:** Please have your media representatives (radio, TV, and newspaper) check in with the tournament manager (Alec Vermaire) for information and registration.

- Eating w Coolers:** Teams will be allowed to put their food coolers, etc in the Commons. Tables and garbage cans will be provided in the Commons for eating (Please clean up when you have finished eating). **NO COOLERS OR LARGE PARCELS OF FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BLEACHERS.**
- Hospitality Room:** NO KIDS/STUDENTS/WRESTLERS/CHEERLEADERS ALLOWED!
Please remember to clean up after eating.
- State Photos:** Photographs of the top 4 placers will be taken in the auxiliary gym immediately after the presentation of each weight class award. Please assist us in getting your athletes to the auxiliary gym for their photo! School warm up tops (zippered or buttoned) and bottoms are required attire for photo session (NO HATS IN PICTURES).
- Admissions:** All day passes \$9.00 Adults, \$7.00 Seniors/Students with ASB





Passes: The Region IV Tournament pass policy will follow WIAA guidelines:

- One (1) pass per participant
- One (1) pass administrator/supervisor (**no floor access**)
- One (1) cheer supervisory pass (**no floor access**) issued at door when cheer team arrives
- Coaches passes:
 - 2 passes (provided in team info packet)
 - 3 passes (upon request by tournament manager if team has 3-9 participants)
 - 4 passes (upon request by tournament manager if team has 10 or more participants)
 - The WIAA fee is \$25 per coach for extra floor passes

No school or district passes will be accepted.

Cheerleaders: Cheerleaders from participating schools in uniform will be admitted free of charge. A cheer coach must be present. No more than (4) cheerleaders will be allowed on the mat at any time.

Valuables: Each team is responsible for their own valuables.

Towels: Each team must provide its own towels.
